### SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST LESSON

R. The first lesson is from the book of 1 Corinthians 9: 16-23:

<sup>16</sup> For if I preach the gospel, that gives me no ground for boasting. For necessity is laid upon me. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel! <sup>17</sup> For if I do this of my own will, I have a reward, but if not of my own will, I am still entrusted with a stewardship. <sup>18</sup> What then is my reward? That in my preaching I may present the gospel free of charge, so as not to make full use of my right in the gospel. <sup>19</sup> For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them. <sup>20</sup> To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to win Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law (though not being myself under the law) that I might win those under the law. <sup>21</sup> To those outside the law I became as one outside the law (not being outside the law of God but under the law of Christ) that I might win those outside the law. <sup>22</sup> To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some. <sup>23</sup> I do it all for the sake of the gospel, that I may share with them in its blessings.

R. This is the word of the Lord *C. Thanks be to God*.

#### RESPONSIVE PSALM R. The responsive Psalm is Psalm 147:1-11:

- R. <sup>1</sup> Praise the LORD! For it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant, and a song of praise is fitting.
- C. <sup>2</sup> The LORD builds up Jerusalem; he gathers the outcasts of Israel.
- R. <sup>3</sup> He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.
- C. <sup>4</sup> He determines the number of the stars; he gives to all of them their names.
- R. <sup>5</sup> Great is our Lord, and abundant in power; his understanding is beyond measure.
- C. <sup>6</sup> The LORD lifts up the humble; he casts the wicked to the ground.
- R. <sup>7</sup> Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving; make melody to our God on the lyre!
- C. 8 He covers the heavens with clouds; he prepares rain for the earth; he makes grass grow on the hills.
- R. <sup>9</sup> He gives to the beasts their food, and to the young ravens that cry.
- C. 10 His delight is not in the strength of the horse, nor his pleasure in the legs of a man,
- R. 11 but the LORD takes pleasure in those who fear him, in those who hope in his steadfast love.
- R. Here ends the reading of the Psalm. Please rise as you are able for the reading of the Gospel.

# **GOSPEL LESSON** (Please rise as you are able)

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the 1<sup>st</sup> chapter, verses 29-39:

# C. Glory to you, O Lord

"29 And immediately he left the synagogue and entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. <sup>30</sup> Now Simon's mother-in-law lay ill with a fever, and

immediately they told him about her. <sup>31</sup> And he came and took her by the hand and lifted her up, and the fever left her, and she began to serve them. <sup>32</sup> That evening at sundown they brought to him all who were sick or oppressed by demons. <sup>33</sup> And the whole city was gathered together at the door. <sup>34</sup> And he healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons. And he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him. <sup>35</sup> And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed. <sup>36</sup> And Simon and those who were with him searched for him, <sup>37</sup> and they found him and said to him, "Everyone is looking for you." <sup>38</sup> And he said to them, "Let us go on to the next towns, that I may preach there also, for that is why I came out." <sup>39</sup> And he went throughout all Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and casting out demons.

P. This is the Gospel of the Lord. *C. Praise to you, O Christ.*
