SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST LESSON

R. The first lesson is from the book of Deuteronomy 4: 1-2, 6-9:

¹ "And now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the rules that I am teaching you, and do them, that you may live, and go in and take possession of the land that the LORD, the God of your fathers, is giving you. ² You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you. ⁶ Keep them and do them, for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the

sight of the peoples, who, when they hear all these statutes, will say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.' ⁷ For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as the LORD our God is to us, whenever we call upon him? ⁸ And what great nation is there, that has statutes and rules so righteous as all this law that I set before you today? ⁹ "Only take care, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things that your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. Make them known to your children and your children's children—

- R. ¹²⁹ Your testimonies are wonderful; therefore my soul keeps them.
- C. ¹³⁰ The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.
- R. ¹³¹ I open my mouth and pant, because I long for your commandments.
- C. ¹³² Turn to me and be gracious to me, as is your way with those who love your name.
- $R.\,^{133}$ Keep steady my steps according to your promise, and let no iniquity get dominion over me.
- C. ¹³⁴ Redeem me from man's oppression, that I may keep your precepts.
- R. ¹³⁵ Make your face shine upon your servant, and teach me your statutes.
- C. ¹³⁶ My eyes shed streams of tears, because people do not keep your law.

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark 7: 14-23:

C. Glory to you, O Lord

¹⁴ And he called the people to him again and said to them, "Hear me, all of you, and understand: ¹⁵ There is nothing outside a person that by going into him can defile him, but the things that come out of a person are what defile him." ^{[a] 17} And when he had entered the house and left the people, his disciples asked him about the parable. ¹⁸ And he said to them, "Then are you also without understanding? Do you not see that whatever goes into a person from outside cannot defile him, ¹⁹ since it enters not his heart but his stomach, and is expelled?" ^[b] (Thus he declared all foods clean.) ²⁰ And he said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. ²¹ For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, ²² coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. ²³ All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."
