R. ⁵ Yet you have made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor.

C. ⁶ You have given him dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under his feet,

R.⁷ all sheep and oxen, and also the beasts of the field,

C. ⁸ the birds of the heavens, and the fish of the sea, whatever passes along the paths of the seas.

R. ⁹O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

¹⁶ Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. ¹⁷ And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. ¹⁸ And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." P. This is the Gospel of the Lord. *C. Praise to you, O Christ.*
