LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH (please rise as you are able)

Please read in unison: Mark 1:1-4

¹"The beginning of the good news about Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God,² as it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way" -3 "a voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'" ⁴ And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins."

P. Let us pray, C. Dear God, we light the third candle of Advent, the John the Baptist candle. Through John the Baptist, God asks us to prepare the way of the Lord whom Isaiah calls "The Prince of Peace". We look with hope for the day that Christ's peace will reign in our world. Amen.

SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST LESSON

R. The first lesson is from the book of 1 Thessalonians 5: 16-24:

¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray without ceasing, ¹⁸ give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. ¹⁹ Do not quench the Spirit. ²⁰ Do not despise prophecies, ²¹ but test everything; hold fast what is good. ²² Abstain from every form of evil. ²³ Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴ He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it.

R. This is the word of the Lord *C. Thanks be to God*.

SECOND READING R. Our responsive Psalm is Psalm 126:

- R. ¹ When the LORD restored the fortunes of Zion, we were like those who dream.
- C. ² Then our mouth was filled with laughter, and our tongue with shouts of joy; then they said among the nations, "The LORD has done great things for them."
- R. ³ The LORD has done great things for us; we are glad.
- C. 4 Restore our fortunes, O LORD, like streams in the Negeb!
- R.5 Those who sow in tears shall reap with shouts of joy!
- C. ⁶ He who goes out weeping, bearing the seed for sowing, shall come home with shouts of joy, bringing his sheaves with him.
- R. Here ends our responsive reading. Please rise as you are able for the reading of the Gospel.

GOSPEL LESSON (Please rise as you are able)

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the 3rd chapter, verses 1-6:

C. Glory to you, O Lord

¹Again he entered the synagogue, and a man was there with a withered hand. ² And they watched Jesus, to see whether he would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse him. ³ And he said to the man with the withered hand, "Come here." ⁴ And he said to them, "Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to kill?" But they were silent. ⁵ And he looked around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, and said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and his hand was restored. ⁶ The Pharisees went out and immediately held counsel with the Herodians against him, how to destroy him.

P. This is the Gospel of the Lord. C. Praise to you, O Christ.
