SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST LESSON

R. The first lesson is from the book of Romans 12:1-8:

¹ I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ² Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. ³ For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith

that God has assigned. ⁴ For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. ⁶ Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; ⁷ if service, in our serving; the one who teaches, in his teaching; ⁸ the one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness.

R. This is the word of the Lord *C. Thanks be to God.*

RESPONSIVE PSALM R. The responsive Psalm is Psalm 138:

- R. ¹I give you thanks, O LORD, with my whole heart; before the gods I sing your praise;
- C. ²I bow down toward your holy temple and give thanks to your name for your steadfast love and your faithfulness, for you have exalted above all things your name and your word.
- R. ³ On the day I called, you answered me; my strength of soul you increased.
- C. 4 All the kings of the earth shall give you thanks, O LORD, for they have heard the words of your mouth,
- R. ⁵ and they shall sing of the ways of the LORD, for great is the glory of the LORD.
- C. ⁶ For though the LORD is high, he regards the lowly, but the haughty he knows from afar.
- R. ⁷Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you preserve my life; you stretch out your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and your right hand delivers me.
- C. ⁸ The LORD will fulfill his purpose for me; your steadfast love, O LORD, endures forever. Do not forsake the work of your hands.

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the 6th chapter, verses 9-13:

C. Glory to you, O Lord

⁹ You, therefore, pray like this: 'Our Father in heaven! May your Name be kept holy. ¹⁰May your Kingdom come, your will be done on earth as in heaven. ¹¹ Give us the food we need today. ¹²Forgive us what we have done wrong, as we too have forgiven those who have wronged us. ¹³And do not lead us into hard testing but keep us safe from the Evil One. For kingship, power and glory are yours forever. *Amen*.'
