What is a Small Group?

Many small groups focus on Bible study such as the "Men's Bible Study and Fellowship" group that meets Wednesday mornings. However, small groups can have a slightly different focus, such as the "Blessed and Unstoppable" women's group led by Bev Valentine which provides Christian support for working women.

Group leaders invite their family, friends, neighbors, and anyone they think would enjoy being in a group of from 3-to-10 people. They

meet weekly for an agreed upon number of weeks.

Pastor Michael Birnbaum, Pastor Assistant Eileen Pressler, President Ken Bourlier, Vice-President Bob Pressler, Mission Coordinator Rosie Freeman & Secretary Sharon Peterson.

Meetng opened with prayer. June minutes approved.

Items to be added: Rosie, AAPC & WOW

Pastor's Report: Pastor Michael Birnbaum Pastor gave a full report on Pastoral care. Would like to order U.S. & Christian Flags for the front of the church. Rosie will ask WOW if they would like to do this project. Christmas in July is set for 19th. Pastor made a motion to explore the 40 Lutheran denominations for additional affiliation's and a change to the constitution in January to accommodate addition affiliations. Council approved. Motion approved to make Pastor's new extension contract call through Dec 31, 2020

Pastor Assistant: Eileen Pressler Pastors next Sunday off is July 26, Pastor Steve Bergeson will be our supply pastor. Sunday July 19th (Christmas in July), discussion on having some sort of treat after worship. Eileen and Rosie will work on doing cookies in packages to hand

out after worship. Easter in August is scheduled for August 23. Plans are to continue using the Fellowship cups for communion at this time. Additional hand sanitizer is available. New stand has been provided with sanitizer. Face masks have been purchased. Subscription to Sermon Writer has been returned, suggest deposit check (\$59.99) into the designated fund for video equipment. Council approved. Numbered offering envelopes have been received. After discussion it was decided to wait until January 2021 to hand them out. Service for Holly Vautier, the wife of Rev. Grif Vautier is the 18th @ 10 am.

<u>Vice President-Financial Report:</u> Bob Pressler Our monthly rent payment was made on July 1st. Placed a call to Suddenlink in regards to internet and phone service. After talking to a salesperson he said that since we are a church and would be considered a business the cost would be \$130 per month. Council decided to wait at this time before making a change. Reports approved. Council approved.

<u>Mission Coordinator:</u> Rosie Freeman WOW is asking that our annual Yard Sale be held on Oct 2nd/3rd. Advice and Aid Pregnancy Center (AAPC) Tea is scheduled for October 24, 2020. Motion approved to contribute \$100 toward the Tea as in past years. Rosie will look at doing an Action Project for the Tea. Council approved. Rosie will talk to Root to see what is needed and then look at doing an Action project for them.

<u>Old Business:</u> Media Team Project: Sharon showed council 3 camera's which Pam Burgett had recommended. Council will provide the funds (up to \$500) for this.
