Notes: 104 vs. 31: May the Lord be pleased and able to rejoice in me and others—His works. It is motivating to think of my day as being a "work" that will be worthy of His rejoicing.

106:47 "Asking to be "gathered from the nations" also applies to us today as we constantly need to have our thoughts/lives/attention spans "gathered" from afar so we can get back to praising and worshipping Him—non-stop.

Day 22

Psalm 108

- 1My heart is steadfast, O God; I will sing and make music with all my soul.
- ²Awake, harp and lyre! I will awaken the dawn.
- 3I will praise You, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing of You among the peoples.
- ⁴For great is Your love, higher than the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the skies.
- ⁵Be exalted, O God, above the heavens, and let Your glory be over all the earth.
- 6Save us and help us with Your right hand, that those You love may be delivered.
- ⁷God has spoken from His sanctuary: "In triumph I will parcel out Shechem and measure off the Valley of Succoth.

Indeed, the beginning of problem solving in our lives is honoring/praising Him. It means trusting and learning that time spent honoring/praising Him is returned tenfold in problems solved and understanding/wisdom gained. Trust Him, try doing it His way (praise first).

Notes: vs 16, I think I'm getting it that the earth belonging to us just doesn't refer to environmental stewardship issues but, perhaps more importantly, it is a reminder that He wants us to use this time "do the assignment" He gives of using this time as a school, e.g.learning to live out His Gospel -- to take care of the peoples of the earth, and all their needs, service to the poor, etc.

Praise be to You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as You were in the beginning, are now, and will be forever and ever. Amen!

Day 24

Psalm 116

We aren't living our days we are living out HIS days, His plan, His future.

Notes:

Ps 119:174, Salvation isn't just "getting to go to Heaven", it is being saved by Him from the daily threats and hurts that can steal our peace which He desires to give to us—His divine perspective on how unimportant all the things are we tend to worry ourselves with.

Praise be to You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as You were in the beginning, are now, and will be forever and ever. Amen!

Notes:

- Vs 4: "For the Lord has chosen you to be his own, to be his treasured possession."—one of the most comforting verses in scripture.
- Vs. 6, "whatever pleases Him" is ALWAYS our good—that we can be certain of. How comforting it is to know that this all-powerful God, the Lord of Heaven and Earth, all space and all time—is pleased by taking care of His children's needs! An added bonus is the He also knows those eternal needs better than we ourselves, also comforting when we may not be sure of what and how things are happening around us.

- Give thanks to the Lord , for He is good. His love endures forever.
- ²Give thanks to the God of gods. His love endures forever.
- 3Give thanks to the Lord of lords: His love endures forever.
- 4to Him who alone does great wonders, His love endures forever.
- 5Who by His understanding made the heavens, His love endures forever.
- 6Who spread out the earth upon the waters, His love endures forever.
- 7Who made the great lights- His love endures forever.
- 8the sun to govern the day, His love endures forever.

Notes:

Ps 136:5 says He created the heavens by His understanding. I usually think of Him creating by His Power and awesome Holiness, but that He would use His understanding to create such an indescribable expanse of the universe tells me it is not only by a design that only He can fathom (and scientists are just starting to understand) but that same understanding is at work in me and others as He creates our lives and futures. Awesome! Comforting!

Ps 136: Verses 23 and 24 are the prayer of those whom He has rescued from addictions, mental issues, sinful pasts, and other life tragedies. Indeed, in the end, we discover that only He can deliver us from those enemies that would seek to take our eternal lives from us. And He does!

"...Who remembered us in our low estate..." is such a generous way of putting it...when we who have been rescued have lived such tragically hurtful and harmful lives. It can also refer to depression.

Closing: Praise be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as He was in the beginning, is now, and shall be for ever and ever. Amen.

Day 27

Psalm 138

Notes:

Vs. :1, Amazing demonstration of the power of praise: when confronted with a temptation ("other gods"), admit you are powerless, then PRAISE the true God of All, even if only as one saying His name with reverence.....as this becomes a Holy Habit, it becomes more and more effective.

Vs. 3, Needs to be my "mantra" @

Vs.7 It seems I am always walking in the midst of trouble ⊗

Psalm 140

13Surely the righteous will praise Your

name and the upright will live before You.

Closing Prayer:

Praise be to You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as You were in the beginning, are now, and will be forever and ever. Amen!

Day 28

Psalm 144

- Praise be to the Lord my Rock, Who trains my hands for war, my fingers for battle
- 9I will sing a new song to You, O God; on the ten-stringed lyre I will make music to You.
- 10to the One Who gives victory to kings, Who delivers His servant David from the deadly sword.

Notes:

Ps 144:1 He also trains our minds for war, our thoughts for battle as we struggle daily against temptation and the seduction of worldly desires. Thanks be to Him, the victory is His!

Ps 144:9, "Singing a new song" isn't just a cutsy phrase for coffee mugs at Bible bookstores @, it is an affirmation of forgiveness and our understanding that no matter how badly, even tragically, we have messed up or back-slidden, it is ALWAYS possible to start over, ready to sing yet another new song, a new verse, as it were, as He always makes good on his promise to be faithful, patient and forgiving—note how many times in these Thirty Days of Praise that assurance is proclaimed—believe it!

Day 29

Psalm 146

- ⁵Let the saints rejoice in this honor and sing for joy on their beds.
- 6May the praise of God be in their mouths.

Notes: "a new song" = a new life lived for Him.

- ³Praise Him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise Him with the harp and lyre,
- 4praise Him with tambourine and dancing, praise Him with the strings and flute,
- 5praise Him with the clash of cymbals, praise Him with resounding cymbals.
- 6Let everything that has breath praise

the Lord . Praise the Lord .

Note: Ps 150:1, "His Sanctuary" is both within us and wherever He has placed us at any moment, it can also be tha special place you go to meet Him and be alone—everyone needs one of these places. Of course, any gathering of brothers and sister to worship creates the ultimate sanctuary.

Note: We live to praise Him...

Day 31—Or a Praise Encore for those months without 31 days! :
