PRAYER OF CONFESSION TO PREPARE FOR WORSHIP

P. Let us pray, *C. Loving God, we confess that at times we do not share in the joy of the resurrection but are caught in the worries of the world. We confess that we do not always live in the spirit of new life but remain discontent, grumbling and anxious. Forgive us for not sharing in the Good News. Forgive us when we find it more comfortable to worry and complain than to risk the joy and encouragement of new life in Christ. Call us back to Your ways, O God, to seek hope and reconciliation, restoration and peace. In the name of the Risen Christ, we pray. Amen*

ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS

P. Christ is Risen! The stone is rolled away, the tomb found empty. Mary calls out, "I have seen the Lord!" We have seen Christ, too, in every helping hand, in every heartfelt gift, in every choice to restore life in this world. We are called to this new life, a life of forgiveness and reconciliation. You are forgiven; accept your forgiveness and know that God loves you

and desires great joy for your life. Walk forward on this journey of faith, knowing your brothers and sisters are with you.

SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST READING

R. The first reading is from the book of 1 Corinthians 15:1-11:

Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, ² and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. ³ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. ⁶ Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. ⁷ Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. ⁸ Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me. ⁹ For I am the least of the apostles, unworthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. ¹⁰ But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me was not in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them, though it was not I, but the grace of God that is with me. ¹¹ Whether then it was I or they, so we preach and so you believed.

LITANY-EVERY DAY IS EASTER R. Please join me in our Litany for Easter.

- R. When Thomas touched the wounds and set himself free, *C. it was Easter day!*
- R. When Peter's three yes answers to Jesus' question "Do you love me?" finished his three denials, *C. it was Easter day!*
- R. When Mary, ready to embalm the dead, ran in fear from the empty tomb,

C. it was Easter day!

R. When the disciples looked from afar at a breakfast of fish on the beach,

C. it was Easter day!

- R. When Emmaus became the place the disciples welcomed a stranger on the road and later broke bread with him, *C. it was Easter day!*
- R. When Paul was blinded by the light and recognized the voice in his head,

C. it was Easter day!

R. When the hungry are fed at the same table as the rich, C. it IS Easter day!

- R. When weapons are beaten and peace is a word to be shouted, C. it IS Easter day!
- R. When the stranger is welcomed in community and the lonely are restored to relationship,
- C. it IS Easter day!
- R. He is Risen!
- C. It IS Easter day! HE IS RISEN INDEED! ALLELUIA!
- R. Here ends the Litany. We sing the next part of our Easter Anthem.

EASTER ANTHEM "I Know That My Redeemer Lives" (part 2)

GOSPEL LESSON (please rise as you are able)

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the 16th chapter, verses 1 through 7:

C. Glory to you, O Lord.

¹ When the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint him. ² And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb. ³ And they were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" ⁴ And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back—it was very large. ⁵ And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. ⁶ And he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him. ⁷ But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you."

P. This is the Gospel of the Lord. *C. Praise to you, O Christ.*

NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through Him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. I acknowledge one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins. I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
