- P. God has had mercy on us. He sent his Son to seek and to save the lost, to seek and to save us. Jesus suffered, died and rose from the dead to bring us forgiveness and life. I announce to you that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- C. Be our Shepherd, Lord, and hold us safely in your mighty hand!

WORSHIP SONG "Be Thou My Vision"

<u>SCRIPTURE LESSONS</u> <u>FIRST READING</u>

R. The first reading is from the book of Hebrews 5: 5-10

⁵ So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"; ⁶ as he says also in another place, "You are a priest forever, after the order of Melchizedek." ⁷ In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to him who was

able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence. ⁸ Although he was a son, he learned obedience through what he suffered. ⁹ And being made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him, ¹⁰ being designated by God a high priest after the order of Melchizedek.

R. This is the word of the Lord *C. Thanks be to God*.

RESPONSIVE PSALM R. The responsive Psalm is Psalm 51:1-12

- R. Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.
- C. ² Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!
- R. ³ For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.
- C. ⁴ Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.
- R. ⁵ Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.
- C. ⁶ Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.
- R. ⁷ Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
- C. ⁸Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.
- R. ⁹ Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.
- C. 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.
- R. ¹¹ Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.
- C. 12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.
- R. Here ends the reading of the Psalm. Please rise as you are able for the reading of the Gospel.

GOSPEL LESSON (Please rise as you are able)

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. John 12: 20-33

C. Glory to you, O Lord

²⁰ Now among those who went up to worship at the feast were some Greeks. ²¹ So these came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, "Sir, we wish to see Jesus." ²² Philip went and told Andrew; Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus. ²³ And Jesus answered them, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. ²⁴ Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. ²⁵ Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. ²⁶ If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him. ²⁷ "Now is my soul troubled. And what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But for this purpose I have come to this hour. ²⁸ Father, glorify your name." Then a voice came from heaven: "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again." ²⁹ The crowd that stood there and heard it said that it had thundered. Others said, "An angel has spoken to him." ³⁰ Jesus answered, "This voice has come for your sake, not mine. ³¹ Now is the judgment of this

world; now will the ruler of this world be cast out. ³² And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." ³³ He said this to show by what kind of death he was going to die.

P. This is the Gospel of the Lord. C. Praise to you, O Christ.
