SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST LESSON

R. The first lesson is from the book of 1 John 5:1-5:

¹Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him. ² By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. ³ For this is the love of

God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. ⁴ For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. ⁵ Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

R. This is the word of the Lord *C. Thanks be to God*.

RESPONSIVE PSALM R. The responsive Psalm is Psalm 98:

- R. ¹ Oh sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things! His right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him.
- C. ² The LORD has made known his salvation; he has revealed his righteousness in the sight of the nations.
- R. ³ He has remembered his steadfast love and faithfulness to the house of Israel. All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.
- C. ⁴ Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and sing praises!
- R. ⁵ Sing praises to the LORD with the lyre, with the lyre and the sound of melody!
- C. ⁶ With trumpets and the sound of the horn make a joyful noise before the King, the LORD!
- R. ⁷Let the sea roar, and all that fills it; the world and those who dwell in it!
- C. ⁸ Let the rivers clap their hands; let the hills sing for joy together
- R. ⁹ before the LORD, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity.
- R. Here ends the reading of the Psalm. Please rise as you are able for the reading of the Gospel.

GOSPEL LESSON (Please rise as you are able)

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the 15th chapter, verses 9-17:

C. Glory to you, O Lord.

⁹ As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. ¹⁰ If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. ¹² "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. ¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command you. ¹⁵ No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. ¹⁶ You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you. ¹⁷ These things I command you, so that you will love one another.

P. This is the Gospel of the Lord. *C. Praise to you, O Christ.*
