SCRIPTURE LESSONS FIRST LESSON

R. The first lesson is from the book of Romans 8:26-39:

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.
 And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God. ²⁸ And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his

purpose. ²⁹ For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. ³⁰ And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified. ³¹ What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? ³³ Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. ³⁴ Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? ³⁶ As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

R. This is the word of the Lord *C. Thanks be to God.*

- R. ¹²⁹ Your testimonies are wonderful; therefore my soul keeps them.
- C. ¹³⁰ The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.
- R. ¹³¹I open my mouth and pant, because I long for your commandments.
- C. ¹³² Turn to me and be gracious to me, as is your way with those who love your name.
- R. ¹³³ Keep steady my steps according to your promise, and let no iniquity get dominion over me.
- C. ¹³⁴ Redeem me from man's oppression, that I may keep your precepts.
- R. ¹³⁵ Make your face shine upon your servant, and teach me your statutes.
- C. ¹³⁶ My eyes shed streams of tears, because people do not keep your law.

P. The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the 13th chapter, verses 44-46:

C. Glory to you, O Lord

 44 "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. 45 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls, 46 who, on finding one pearl of great value, went and sold all that he had and bought it.
